Return to Venues!



The government announced that Lockdown 2 will come to an end next week, the new tier system will be effective from Wednesday 2nd December. We are pleased to announce that our classes are able to continue in tier 1, 2 & 3 as ou

Limited Access



- Parents/Carers will not be allowed into the building. All waiting rooms will be closed.
- Use the QR code to sign your child in -You may need to download a QR reader app on your phone.
- Please complete the Health questionnaire every time you sign in.
- Dancers will wait outside ,until the door is opened by the teacher.



Student Checklist

- Go to the toilet before coming to class.
- Where a mask in communal areas e.g hallways, corridors etc. You do NOT need to wear a mask whilst dancing!
- Stop for a temperature check & hand sanitiser at the door.
- Be dressed ready for class, bringing only your dance shoes and water bottle.
- Please bring the inner cardboard tube from a toilet roll to use as a barre protector.



New Studio Policies

- Students will be assigned their own socially distanced 'Dance Box' for each class.
- They will keep their shoes & water in their 'Dance Box'
- Classes are shortened by 5 minutes to allow for sanitisation.
- Following each class all touch points will be cleaned.



Limited Class Sizes

- Class sizes will be limited due to social distancing measures.
- Each venue will have a clear floor plan to assist in maintaining a safe distance apart.



Hand Sanitiser

 Upon entering the building each dancer will stop at the door to receive hand







- We advise the children bring their own hand sanitiser as well if they have it.
- We will also use hand sanitiser during class as needed.

Online Classes

 We will endeavour to run the course inperson however the safety of our students and staff is our top priority and we will always follow government guidance. If the guidance changes and does not allow an in-person course, then will deliver the course online via zoom

Closure of courses due to COVID-19 infection and need to self-isolate:

If a student has been asked to self-isolate or they or a member of their household shows symptoms of COVID-19 when they are due to attend the course, they will not be able to attend. If a student or member of their household tests positive for COVID-19 while the course is running, you will need to notify us immediately and that student will no longer be able to attend on-site.

In the event of a student experiencing COVID-19 symptoms part-way through the course, their bubble will immediately be removed from on-site activities and teaching will be transferred online. In the event of a student testing positive for COVID-19 within 14 days of taking part in our courses, you must notify the office immediately and include our organisation within your track and trace submission.
